How dogs caught me:

When I was eighteen, I bought a fawn male Boxer, a descendant of Argus v. Witwald. He never became a beauty champion, having twice been judged in a beauty contest, but not placed. But due to his education and training, he became an excellent working dog.

Thanks to my second Boxer, the fawn Ch. David v. Monacum (Sire: Carlino v. Nassau-Oranien) I discovered my love for beauty contests and, in 1986, became a judge. Sometime later, I took over the Section "Exhibitions" of the Swiss Boxer Club, and, for

a long time now, have also been a "Körmeister" and the president of the Commission for Breeding and Selection. Within the scope of the TKGS (SwissTechnical Commission for Working and Sporting Dogs) I act as a performance judge in "Endurance Tests".

Another Boxer, the fawn Ch. Henry v.d. Raufbolden, has been a member of our family for almost 12 years.

And I shall never forget my last Boxer, the golden brindle Ch. Ravel du Val d'Europe, who has been my companion for near to 13 years.

My activities as a judge have led me to almost every country of the European continent, but also to Israel and twice over the Channel to England, and even to Australia and New Zealand. On these occasions, I have had - among others - the honour and pleasure to judge at World Dog Exhibitions, Eurodog-Shows, ATIBOX World Boxer Shows and National Breed Exhibitions. Once again this year I had the honour of judging the boxers at the World Dog Show in Geneva.

Since 2007, I have also been judging the new Swiss breed "Continental Bulldog", which was provisionally recognised by the FCI on 30.03.2022. For this breed too, I am a "Körmeister" and a member of the Breed Commission.
